### **Directions For Use**

Read the entire label before using this product. CALIFORNIA RESIDENTS: DILUTE PRODUCT AT (1:9) WITH WATER. Be sure to test in an inconspicuous area before using. Remove as much of the staining material as possible with a bone scraper prior to applying this product. Apply a small amount of this product and agitate using the bone scraper. Blot drying using a white, absorbent cloth. Rinse with water and blot dry.
